## 1. Rainbow Bunting



This cheerful bunting is the perfect way to add a touch of whimsy to your garden. Made from bright and colorful fabrics, it's sure to brighten up any space.

**Materials:**

- Fabric scraps in a variety of colors

- Bias tape
- Scissors
- Needle and thread

### **Materials:**

3. Turn the planter right side out and fill it with soil.
4. Plant your flowers and enjoy your new fabric planter!

### **3. Painted Flower Pots**



Give your plain flower pots a makeover with a coat of paint. You can use any color you like, but bright and cheerful colors will really make your garden pop.

**Materials:**

- Flower pots

- Paint
- Paintbrush

**Instructions:**

1. Clean the flower pots and make sure they are dry.
2. Apply a coat of paint to the flower pots and let dry.
3. If desired, apply a second coat of paint.

**4. Fabric Windsocks**



These fabric windsocks are a great way to add a touch of movement and color to your garden. They're also a great way to use up fabric scraps.

**Materials:**

- Fabric scraps
- Scissors



- Needle and thread
- Ribbon

### **Instructions:**

1. Cut out a long strip of fabric from your fabric scrap. The strip should be about 6 inches wide and 36 inches long.
2. Fold the strip in half lengthwise and sew the edges together.
3. Turn the tube right side out and gather one end. Tie a ribbon around the gathered end to create the top of the windsock.
4. Attach the windsock to a tree branch or fence post and enjoy!

### **5. Fabric Flags**



These fabric flags are a great way to add a touch of patriotism to your garden. They're also a great way to use up fabric scraps.

**Materials:**

- Fabric scraps
- Scissors

- Needle and thread
- String

### **Instructions:**

1. Cut out a rectangle from your fabric scrap. The size of the rectangle will depend on how big you want your flag to be.
2. Fold the rectangle in half lengthwise and sew the edges together.
3. Turn the flag right side out and insert a string into the top of the flag.
4. Hang your flag from a tree branch or fence post.

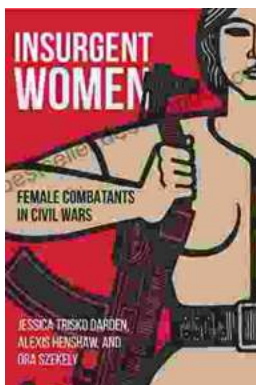
