Materials

- Size 10 crochet thread
- Size 10 crochet hook
- Scissors

- Yarn needle
- Optional: Blocking board and pins

Gauge

10 stitches and 10 rows = 2 inches

Finished Size

Approximately 18 inches long and 4 inches wide

Instructions

1. Chain 100 stitches.
2. Single crochet into the second chain from the hook and each chain across. (99 single crochets)
3. Chain 3 and turn.
4. Double crochet into the chain-3 space and each single crochet across. (99 double crochets)
5. Chain 3 and turn.
6. Skip the first double crochet and double crochet into the next double crochet. *Skip the next double crochet and double crochet into the next double crochet. Repeat from * across. (49 double crochets)
7. Chain 3 and turn.
8. Skip the first double crochet and double crochet into the next double crochet. *Skip the next double crochet and treble crochet into the next double crochet. Repeat from * across. (49 treble crochets)
9. Chain 3 and turn.

10. Skip the first treble crochet and treble crochet into the next treble crochet. *Skip the next treble crochet and double crochet into the next treble crochet. Repeat from * across. (49 double crochets)
11. Chain 3 and turn.
12. Skip the first double crochet and double crochet into the next double crochet. *Skip the next double crochet and slip stitch into the next double crochet. Repeat from * across. (49 slip stitches)
13. Fasten off and weave in loose ends.

Finishing

To finish the collar, you can block it to help it keep its shape. To do this, lay the collar flat on a blocking board and pin it into place. Use a spray bottle to dampen the collar and then let it dry completely.

Once the collar is dry, you can attach it to your clothing. To do this, simply sew or pin the collar to the neckline of your garment.

Variations

There are many ways to customize this pattern to create a unique collar. Here are a few ideas:

- Use a different type of yarn, such as cotton, silk, or wool.
- Change the size of the collar by adding or subtracting rows.
- Add embellishments, such as beads or sequins.
- Create a different lace pattern by following a different crochet chart.

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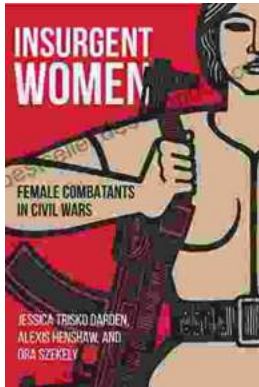
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
