
Ron Paul Speaks: The Life and Legacy of a Libertarian Icon

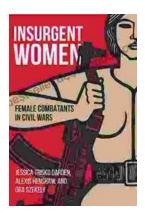
