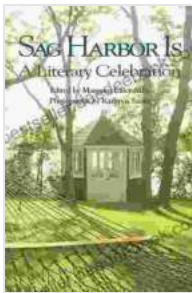

Book Signings and Other Special Events

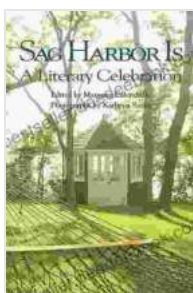
