## Initial Application Process

To apply for an airman certificate, you must meet the following requirements:

- Be at least 17 years old

- Be a U.S. citizen or lawful permanent resident
- Be able to read, write, and speak English
- Have a high school diploma or equivalent
- Pass a medical examination
- Pass a knowledge test
- Pass a practical test

The initial application process can be completed online or by mail. The online application process is available at the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) website. The mail-in application process can be found in the Airman Certification Standards (ACS).

## **Renewal Process**

Airman certificates must be renewed every two years. The renewal process can be completed online or by mail. The online renewal process is available at the FAA website. The mail-in renewal process can be found in the ACS.

To renew your airman certificate, you must meet the following requirements:

- Be current on your medical certificate
- Have completed a flight review within the past two years
- Have logged at least 50 hours of flight time in the past two years
- Pass a knowledge test (if required)

- Pass a practical test (if required)

## **Ratings**

Airman certificates can be issued with a variety of ratings. Ratings indicate the type of aircraft or operations that the airman is authorized to fly. The most common ratings are:

- Private pilot
- Commercial pilot
- Instrument rating
- Multi-engine rating
- Flight instructor rating

To obtain a rating, you must meet the following requirements:

- Have a valid airman certificate
- Pass a written test
- Pass a practical test

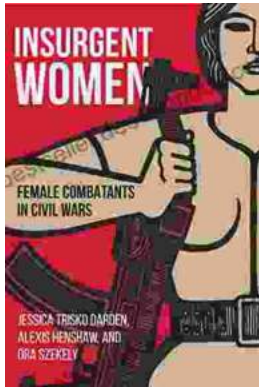
