

Vampirina Ballerina: A Spine-Tingling Tale of Dance and Courage



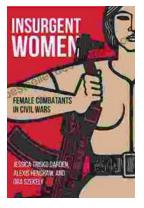
